



## Minutes Of Meeting held with Officers regarding SAGY Village Melhura under The Chairmanship of District Dev. Commissioner at Circuit House Shopian on 30.07.2015 at 02:30 PM

A Meeting under the Chairmanship of District Dev. Commissioner Shopian was held at Circuit House Shopian on 30-07-2015 to review and assess the progress of implementation of Saansad Adarash Gram Yojna in Village Melhura. All the District Level Officers and the concerned sectoral officers participated in the meeting. A threadbare discussion on different sectors of the village Development Plan was held and the concerned department heads presented the status of activities being carried out in the village and future strategy to be adopted for effective implementation of the plan. The progress shown by different line Departments and the directions issued by District Dev. Commissioner are as under:-

01	Animal Husbandry	<p><b>Achievements so far:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>01. A veterinary facility has already been created in one of the recently constructed prefabricated Govt. huts and adequate staff has been posted.</li><li>02. Artificial insemination facility has also been created and the necessary equipment is being installed.</li><li>03. Under NMPS, feed supplements have already distributed among 12 beneficiaries of village Melhura out of the 51 cases sanctioned for the entire District.</li></ol> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>01. Chicks to be provided to the villagers at highly subsidized rates under backyard poultry development. J&amp;K Bank was directed to explore the possibilities of providing the subsidy component.</li><li>02. The Department was directed to expedite its other interventions like dairy farming; construction of animal excreta pits, poultry farming and cattle sheds.</li></ol>
02	Electricity Distribution	<p><b>Achievements so far:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>01. PVC cable already stands installed at identified places.</li><li>02. A hundred KV Sub station stands already installed at Ziayarat Sharief Herpora Melhura.</li></ol> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>01. The Department was directed to install iron poles throughout the village within one week.</li><li>02. Executive Office of the Municipality was directed to install 15 LED street lights and other 15 were to be installed by Executive Engineer PDD within 3 weeks time.</li></ol>

		<p>03. The Department was also directed to expedite other remodeling of LT and HT network activities at the earliest.</p> <p>04. District Dev. Commissioner also announced that one LED lamp would be provided to all AAY/BPL households in the village.</p> <p>05. The District Dev. Commissioner promised to take up the issue of establishment of a workshop with Hon'ble MP to be funded through MPLADS.</p>
03	J& K Bank	<p><b>Achievements so far:-</b></p> <p>01. Under Pradhan Mantri Jandan Yojna the bank has opened accounts for almost all the individuals in the village.</p> <p>02. The structure for installation for ATM has been identified and renovated as well.</p> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <p>01. The Department was directed to expedite the process of installation of ATM.</p> <p>02. Direction for establishment of a Khidmat Centre was also given.</p>
04	Sheep Husbandry	<p><b>Achievements so far:-</b></p> <p>01. A Sub Centre facility has been established in one of the prefabricated huts and necessary staff stands posted there.</p> <p>02. Medicines have also been distributed by the department among sheep rearing families of the village.</p> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <p>01. The Department was directed to provide at least to Ewes sheep units to the village out of 3 units sanctioned for the district.</p> <p>02. Instructions were also issued to impart training in machine sharing to the unemployed youth of the village at the earliest.</p> <p>03. The Department was also directed to construct a dipping tank and create a baton floor facility in the village.</p>
05	Industries	<p><b>Achievements so far:-</b></p> <p>01. A knitting training centre already stands established in the village.</p> <p><b>Achievements to be carried out:-</b></p> <p>01. The Department was directed to complete the enrollment of the eligible beneficiaries under schemes like MSME and PMEGP.</p>
06	Consumer affairs and public Distribution	<p><b>Achievements so far:-</b></p> <p>01. The Department has ensured round the clock availability of LPG at the private outlets of the village.</p> <p>02. In addition to the already existing 4 sale centers, the Department is in the process of providing another sale outlet.</p> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <p>01. The Department is directed to expedite the process of opening up of another sale outlet.</p> <p>02. Full coverage of the ration cards, including the families left out in 2011 census to be completed at the earliest.</p>

07	Agriculture	<p><b>Achievements so far:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. High yielding variety seeds of potato, maize, paddy, oats, vegetables etc have already been provided to the villagers at highly subsidized rates.</li> <li>02. A green house for protected cultivation has already been established.</li> <li>03. 2 No. of shallow wells for irrigation purposes have also been installed in non- irrigated portion of agricultural land.</li> </ol> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. Infrastructure for organic farming, mushroom development and apiculture development to be carried out in the near future.</li> <li>02. Instructions were given by the District Dev. Commissioner for a joint camp by the horticulture and the Agriculture Department for selection of beneficiaries to provide equipment under farm mechanization.</li> </ol>
08	Roads and Buildings	<p><b>Achievements:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. The strengthening and up gradation of Mehura Laktipora road has been taken up. The base has been laid for mechanization. At some places, widening of the road has also been carried out.</li> </ol> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. Directions were issued by the District Dev. Commissioner for completion of the mechanization of the road at the earliest.</li> <li>02. The Department was also directed to take up strengthening and up gradation of Wachi Melhura road as soon as possible.</li> </ol>
09	Health	<p><b>Achievements:-</b></p> <p>The Department has organized special camps in the aftermath of the floods to cater to the basic medicinal requirement and health check up related needs of the villagers.</p> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. The Department was directed to operationalize the sub centre in one of the prefabricated Govt. huts by providing it with adequate staff and machinery equipment, some of which has already been installed there.</li> <li>02. It was also decided to take up the matter of Ambulance service for the villagers with the Hon'ble MP, to be contributed by her out of the MPLADS funds.</li> </ol>
10	Fisheries	<p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. The Department was directed to establish a fish culture rearing unit in the village on the land to be donated by the villagers with 80% subsidy component.</li> </ol>
11	Education	<p><b>Achievements:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. The Department has already carried out the repairment of the flood damaged infrastructure at M/S Melhura and 2 Govt. Primary Schools. Free books and uniform also stands provided to the students.</li> </ol>

		<p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. The Department was directed to adopt one Middle and one Primary School to be developed as Modal Schools. District Dev. Commissioner also announced that he would be adopting one school.</li> <li>02. The Department was directed to deploy staff from nearby High Schools and Hr. Sec. Schools.</li> <li>03. Already existing CAL centre for computer literacy to be made operational by providing it the electricity facility at the earliest.</li> <li>04. Books and uniform free of cost to be provided to the left out students.</li> </ol>
12	Social Welfare	<p><b>Achievements:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. The Department has ensured 100% coverage of the village under merit cum means scholarship.</li> <li>02. Survey has been completed under NSAP and ISSS schemes to identify the eligible beneficiaries.</li> </ol> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>01. Through weed out and renewal process Department to overcome the ceiling problem under different schemes.</li> <li>02. The Department was directed to pursue the ceiling problem with the higher ups.</li> </ol>
13	Public Engineering Health	<p><b>Achievements:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Department has already laid 500 meter length pipes of 2.5 inch diameter in the village. Pipes damaged during desilting of Melhura canal have also been replaced.</li> <li>2. A detailed project report already stands submitted for Melhura water supply scheme to the higher authorities.</li> <li>3. Activities to be carried out:-</li> <li>4. Since the village shares its drinking water supply with Batapora village of Pulwama and receives water supply mainly during night hours, the Department was directed to explore the option of providing water supply to these two villages on rotation basis in consultation with the villagers, so that water remains available during day time as well.</li> </ol>
13	Irrigation	<p><b>Achievements:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Department has carried out the desilting of Melhura canal and its branches in the aftermath of floods.</li> </ol> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Department was directed to frame a convergence plan with the Rural Dev. Department for desalting and concrete lining of the Melhura canal and its branches, with the labour component to be provided by RDD and concrete lining to be carried by the Irrigation Department.</li> </ol>

14	Horticulture	<p><b>Activities to be Carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Directions were issued to the Horticulture and Agriculture department to organize a joint camp for selection of beneficiaries under horticulture mechanization.</li> <li>2. Development of plantation infrastructure and creation of water resources to be taken up at the earliest.</li> <li>3. The Department was directed to identify beneficiaries for pollination support through bee keeping, protected cultivation and organic farming</li> </ol>
15	Rural Development Department	<p><b>Achievements:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Block Development Office Zainapora has been coordinating the activities of all other line Departments and managing the IEC related activities of the scheme since its launch.</li> <li>2. Construction of three community sanitary complexes has been completed by the Department and construction of fourth one under progress.</li> <li>3. The Department has fixed four number of sign boards at different entry points into the village.</li> <li>4. The Department has already provide assistance to 211 families for construction of toilets. 223 more families have been selected and they have been provided approval to go ahead with the construction of toilets.</li> <li>5. 27 fresh cases were selected for assistance under IAY, but the Department could not provide them 1<sup>st</sup> installment as entire available allotment lapsed on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015.</li> <li>6. Under MGNREGA two works have already been completed and three new works have been taken up. The estimates of other works to be taken up on priority are being processed.</li> </ol> <p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Directions were issued by District Dev. Commissioner for formulation of a convergence plan between the Irrigation Department and the Rural Dev. Department for desalting and concrete lining of the Melhura canal and its branches.</li> <li>2. The Department was also directed to identify land for construction of a play ground and Anganwari centre in the village.</li> </ol>
16	Flood Control	<p><b>Activities to be carried out:-</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Breaches in the banks of Rambiara Nalla led to submergence of the village in September 2014. Although breaches have been temporarily plugged, the Department was directed to evolve a mechanism for strengthening of breach-prone portions of the banks immediately, and restore the already plugged breaches wherever they have weakened.</li> </ol>

The Meeting ended with the vote of thanks and District Dev. Commissioner impressed upon all line Departments to act swiftly and in a time bound manner upon the directions issued and come up the expectations of the people.
